1867. - *Phlebotomus* *luteolus* (Walker) is a species of the genus *Phlebotomus*, characterized by the presence of a pale yellow or orange-yellow patch on the wing. It is found in the southern United States, Mexico, and Central America. The larvae are aquatic, feeding on organic matter in streams and ponds. The adults are blood-sucking insects, feeding on mammals and birds. They are often found around human habitations, particularly at night.
