National Atlas of Sweden

SNA Publishing will publish between 1990 and 1995 a government-financed National Atlas of Sweden. The first national atlas, *Atlas över Sverige* was published in 1953–71 by *Svenska Sällskapet för Antropologi och Geografi*, SSAG (the Swedish Society for Anthropology and Geography). The new national atlas describes Sweden in 17 volumes, each of which deals with a separate theme. The organizations responsible for this new national atlas are *Lantmäteriverket*, LMV (the National Land Survey), SSAG and *Statistiska centralbyrån*, SCB (Statistics Sweden). The whole project is under the supervision of a board, consisting of two representatives of each of these organizations and the chief editor. To assist the board and the editors there is a scientific advisory group of three permanent members: Professor Staffan Helmfrid (Chairman), Professor Erik Bylund and Professor Anders Rapp. For this theme Professor Tryggve Troedsson has been coopted to the advisory group as a specialist. A theme manager is responsible for compiling the manuscript for each individual volume. The National Atlas of Sweden is to be published in book form both in Swedish and in English, and in a computer-based version for use in personal computers.
