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National Atlas of Sweden

The first national atlas *Atlas över Sverige* was published in 1953–1971 by *Svenska Sällskapet för Antropologi och Geografi* (SSAG). *Sveriges Nationalatlas Förlag* published between 1990 and 1996 a new Swedish national atlas in 17 thematic volumes. The organizations responsible for this new national atlas were *Lantmäterverket* (the National Land Survey), *Statistiska centralbyrån* (Statistics Sweden) and SSAG. The series was financed by government grants.

This volume, "*Public Health and Health Care*", complements the thematic volumes in the National Atlas of Sweden and is published in co-operation with the National Land Survey and the National Board of Health and Welfare (*Socialstyrelsen*). The first regional volume within the framework of the National Atlas of Sweden, *Atlas över Skåne*, was published in 1999.

The National Atlas of Sweden is published in book form in Swedish and English and in a version for personal computers: *PC-Atlasen-GIS*. Many of the maps can also be viewed on the Internet, www.sna.se, where the maps in the books will be successively updated.
